- 2. Describe 2-3 experiences working with children, youth, and families experiencing health-related services in a healthcare and/or community-based setting. Include your knowledge of development as it relates to these experiences.
- 3. What are your specific strengths and vulnerabilities that you think will contribute to your success in this field and in your future career?
- 4. What are your child life career goals 5-10 years into the profession?
- 5. Please describe your academic background and professional experiences that you believe have prepared you to be successful in an online graduate program.
